








- Enrol with Centrelink for Child Care Benefits
- Enrol with the Murray Bridge North OSHC service
- Arrange to get a Booking Sheet from our service, fill it in and return as soon as possible
- Sign the Consent Forms and return these with your booking sheet.

**What's there to do in Vacation Care**— Apart from the planned program there is always time to play and have fun. For service information please visit the school website, schoolbag or befriend us on facebook. If you require childcare or maybe just a break please contact us or drop in for a visit. We operate a before school, after school and vacation care service from the Old House, between the hours of 6.30am and 6.30pm. There is always plenty to do, yummy food to eat and friendships to be made.

**OSHC Bits:** OSHC currently opens at 6.30 am. There has been some discussion over the last 12 months as to the variability of a 6am opening time. Should this benefit you could you please let staff know so they may keep a record for discussion at management level.

**Management Meetings:** If you have a little time, would like to learn more and assist in the operation of our OSHC program we would love to hear from you. Meetings are held at 3.15pm on Wednesday week 2 and week 6 of each school term.

**Safe Language Zone:** As the Murray Bridge North School is a 'Safe Language Zone' this also applies to the MBNPS OSHC. Swearing is not acceptable in our community therefore in accordance with the Murray Bridge North School guidelines, students will be sent home for swearing while attending OSHC.

**Behaviour at OSHC:**

Inappropriate language and harassment behaviours have recently been seen from the children at OSHC. Staff ask that families please assist us by speaking with their children about keeping such behaviours out so that all attending OSHC can feel safe and happy at all times. All families of children attending the North OSHC are required to follow the North School and the North OSHC behavioural guidelines.

Copies of the Murray Bridge North School OSHC Operating Guidelines are available for anyone requesting a copy or is available from the website.

The Management Committee reserves the right to suspend enrolment if negative behaviour persists.

The North School incorporating the North OSHC does not tolerate bullying or violence of any kind. Offensive behaviour toward a staff member is serious in the extreme.

**Consequences for Inappropriate Behaviour Guidelines:**

Step 1	Warning	discuss behaviour
Step 2	Time Out	5 minutes
Step 3	Time Out	10 minutes
Step 4	Take Home or Office Sit out	For remainder of session if Parent/Caregiver is unavailable
Step 5	Suspension	2 days.
Step 6	After two suspensions of 2 days each	The third suspension will be of 1 week's duration.
Step 7	The fourth suspension	will be for a period of 5 weeks
Step 8	Exclusion from OSHC	Will occur after a fourth suspension.

Staff have the right to bypass steps based on the severity of student behaviour as determined by the OSHC manager on duty.

Periods of suspension from OSHC as described above are based on full-time attendance and will be adjusted accordingly in the case of part-time attendance.
